Who We Are

We are one of the largest volunteer centers in Poland and the largest in Pomerania region. Working with volunteers is our daily work. We are the main organization in Gdańsk that deals with mediation between public institutions and non-governmental organizations, and volunteers. We develop many projects that are aimed at improving this cooperation, as well as reaching an increasing group of people of different ages and activating the local community.

In addition to running a volunteer agency, we also deal with projects such as action volunteering supporting various types of events in Gdańsk, school volunteering, activation of seniors or employee volunteering. We work with volunteers of all ages with different professional and social status, also with migrants.

Foreign volunteering recently became one of the key-points of our development. We received accreditation for hosting/sending/corrdinating in 2018.



Our organization operates in Gdansk, the capital of the Pomeranian Voivodeship. It is one of the largest Polish cities that is located in the north, by the sea. The most numerous group are people between 25 and 39 years old.

It is a very well developed economically, socially and economically city. In Gdańsk there are many cultural institutions offering to participate in and co-create events, space for social activists and universities that make the city teeming with life and is full of young people – including foreigners. Public institutions and non-governmental organizations try to meet the needs and expectations of all age groups.

The advantage is well-developed public transport (buses, trams, trains), as well as space for rest and recreation (beach, boulevards, promenades, squares with benches, parks, outdoor gyms, forests). Gdańsk connects with Sopot and Gdynia, forming the Tri-City. All of them are well connected with each other, which allows for convenient sightseeing and using the possibilities of three urban centers at the same time. The Gdańsk Volunteer Week (GTW) is a citywide event organized and carried out by the Regional Volunteer Center in Gdańsk every year since 2016. It precedes it being celebrated all over the world International Volunteer Day (December 5). This is a celebration for those who already participate in volunteer activities and opportunity more peo<u>ple to</u> understand about the benefits of volunteering. The program of the celebrations includes: debates, meetings, workshops, city poster campaign, training

for volunteers, meetings at schools, Parade, volunteers along the streets of Śródmieście Gdańsk, the Active Gala in the City, during which we solemnly award active volunteers, organizations and senior groups. This year we will celebrate the 5th edition of this event and we would like to invite 10 volunteers to participate.
